OUT (MISSION):

- **TRI-LAKES CARES HOLIDAY FOOD BASKETS:** Every year, Tri-Lakes Cares provides holiday food baskets to eligible clients at Thanksgiving and at Christmas. These are the items needed for this year’s holiday food baskets: apple cider mix, canned pineapple, canned pumpkin, cake mixes, cake frosting, chicken broth, cookie mix, condensed milk, cornbread mix, cranberry sauce, cream of mushroom soup, hot cocoa mix, french fried onions, boxed macaroni and cheese, fruit pie filling, rice mixes, chicken or turkey gravy, marshmallows, pie crust mix, red Jello, stuffing mix, canned yams. If you’d like to provide any of these items, simply drop them in the cart in the narthex.
- Have an expired bottle of Tylenol? No further need for that antacid medication? Don’t flush it into our waterways! Instead, bring your old and expired medications, medical supplies, and **empty** prescription bottles to the shopping cart in the narthex and we will see to it that they help Coloradoans in need. Join us in supporting a **small food pantry and clinic outside of Pueblo that serves migrant workers and the uninsured** using only donated supplies and volunteer staff. Your outdated ibuprofen is another man’s ability to get back to work without pain!
