IN (COMMUNITY):



- **ANNUAL MEETING:** Please plan to join us **NEXT SUNDAY January 27 at 10:00am** for our Annual Meeting. We will approve our new council members, vote on the 2019 budget, and review the year behind us.
- If you did not receive an email with the 2018 Annual Report, you might not be on our email mailing list. If you **do not currently receive email updates** from Trinity about important news and upcoming events, you may simply **text TRINITYMONUMENT to 22828** and you will be prompted to enter your email address to subscribe to our email list. You may also send your contact information to meredith@trinity.org There are a few hard copies of the Annual Report at the Welcome Center in the narthex.
- **HS YOUTH:** Our next Bridge Gathering is **NEXT SUNDAY, January 27 from 6-8pm at Trinity!**
- **FAREWELL CELEBRATION FOR TYG:** Please plan to join us on **Friday, February 1 at Trinity** to celebrate Tyg! **Dinner begins at 6pm followed by a program at 7:30pm** (nursery provided). Dinner is a catered BBQ meal--pulled pork, brisket, smoked turkey, and all the sides! The *minimum* suggested cost is \$10/ adults and \$5/children (4-12). There will be a registration table in the narthex **TODAY** to register! **The deadline to sign up is Tuesday, January 22.**
- Trinity is also collecting new socks and new shoes for Tyg's non-profit, **Wholly Kicks**. The shoes need to be new adult-sized shoes that could be worn outside all day (tennis shoes, work boots, hiking shoes, etc.) There will be a **collection bin in the narthex through January 27** for sock and shoe donations.
- **GROCERY CARD FUNDRAISING for PARKING LOT:** For many years, Trinity has sold grocery cards which kick back 5% of sales to Trinity. These funds have typically been used by families to offset the cost of youth trips and activities. For a limited time, we are going to use this system to raise funds for our **PARKING LOT RE-PAVING PROJECT**. Here is how it works: You purchase a \$10 Safeway or King Soopers reloadable card. The card comes with \$10 on it and each time you shop, you reload your card at the store and use the grocery card to pay for your groceries, gas, prescriptions which gives 5% back to Trinity on all purchases. These funds will go directly into our parking lot fund. **We will be selling grocery cards NEXT SUNDAY, January 27** before early worship, after the Annual Meeting, and after late worship.
